- 1 Applications are welcome from outstanding students of National University of Singapore from any faculty, recognised by his/her peers and recognised for his/her contribution to the field of performing arts whether in theatre, music or dance, both within the NUS Community or the wider local and international arts community.
- 2 Applications for the award may be made by applicants or on their behalf. If a nomination is made on their behalf, the nominee must be informed of the nomination and must agree to the terms and conditions of the award.
- 3 Nominations should be made on prescribed forms and submitted fully completed, together with curriculum vitae, letters of recommendation, press reviews, media coverage and audio-visual materials in support of the nomination by 21 December 2016 to:

- 4 Audio visual materials must be of the highest possible quality and contain recordings of works presented within 6 months of the submission date. Please note that originals should not be sent as all recordings will not be returned.
- 5 The successful applicant will be informed of the outcome of the judging by 2 February 2017.

CRITERIA

- 1 Applications are open to all NUS undergraduate students as well of alumni within the first 6 years after their graduation.
- 2 While applications are welcome from all genres of the arts, nominees in the field of music performance, composition and conducting will receive special attention as Mr Abisheganaden was acknowledged as a pioneer in the field of music, with a strong interest in cultivating music development
- 3 Other important criteria on which the award is based include:
 - a. Contributions to the development of the arts on campus
 - b. Artistic Excellence and Innovation
 - c. Contributions to the development of the arts in the local community
 - d. the value of the proposed course of study to the successful applicant as well as proposed plans to contribute back to the arts on campus through CFA after his return.
- 4 The Paul A. Grant will only be given out to outstanding student candidates who fulfil the criteria as listed above. In the event that no suitable candidate be found in any academic year, the selection committee reserves the right not to award that year and the grant shall be held over to the following year.
